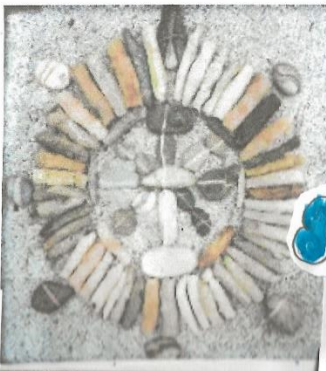

What can you create using just sticks and stones?





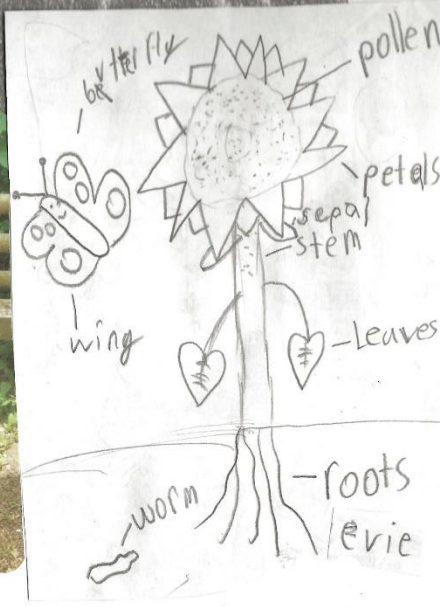
Puffins learning science vocabulary outdoors.

Owlets exploring, investigating, and learning in the garden. The staff teabags, garden, and fruit snack waste, now all go into our compost bin instead of being thrown away.

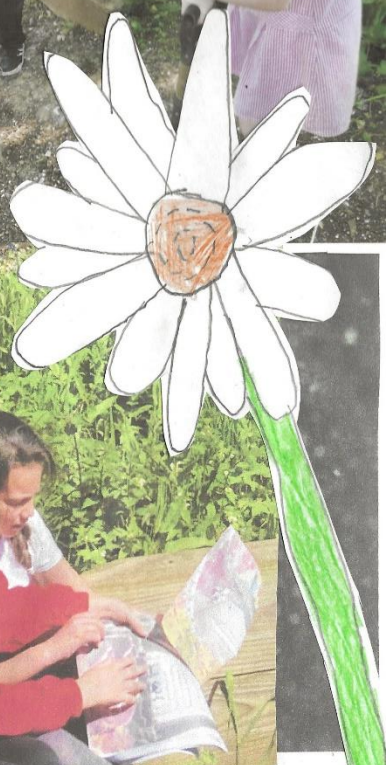




Our eco-reps have been caring for the pond and pond dipping for newts.
