





Refreshing bird bath

You will need

- A large shallow bowl (or an upturned dustbin lid)
- Four bricks, plus gravel or pebblesRain or tap water

How to make

- 1 Place the bricks in a square outside and sit the bowl on top.
- 2 Put the gravel or pebbles in the bottom of the bowl.
- **3** Fill your birdbath with water. Keep it topped up in summer. In winter, melt any ice with warm water.

Just put the stones onto the plate and add water. Make sure the stones aren't fully submerged so bees have a place to perch.


