### **The School Day**

The school day starts at **8.40am**. You can accompany your child into the classroom and teachers will ask you to say goodbye by 8.50am.





When we get to school, we put our

coat on our peg and then we need to put our book bag in the box.



We keep our water bottles on the trolley. If we have a packed lunch this is also where we put our lunch box.



Mid-morning: we have a free healthy snack with our friends. We can also have milk free if we are under 5 years old.

\*To arrange for your child to have free milk whilst they are under 5 years of age, please register online at coolmilk (see leaflet in the welcome pack).

### Lunch

Lunchtime starts at 12:05pm for the reception children.

If you wish, your child can have the free universal hot school lunch. There is a varied menu for the children that includes Halal and vegetarian options. When children select a school lunch, they will need to know how to use a knife and fork, or will be supported by staff to do this.

If they bring a packed lunch please make sure your child has food that they can manage easily.

We ask that you please provide a healthy lunch with no sweets or chocolate, no nut products (as some children suffer from severe allergies) and only water to drink.

The school day finishes at **3:00pm** and you can collect your child from the reception entrance door.

### **Our Uniform**

We are very proud of our uniform at West Blatchington Primary & Nursery School and we appreciate your effort by sending your child in the correct uniform each day.

The uniform is a red sweatshirt, grey trousers, grey skirt or grey pinafore and dark coloured sensible shoes.







Your child will need plimsolls (or non-marking trainers), PE shorts and a white T-shirt for PE and games lessons. You can purchase a PE shoe bag from the school office.



Staff work hard to ensure that your child brings home their own belongings each day. Please help us by clearly marking all clothing, bags, coats and shoes with your child's name.

Your child will also need a book bag so that they can take home reading books and important letters from the school.



Outdoor play is a vital part of the Early Years curriculum and children have access to the outside area all year round and in all weathers. The school provides wet weather gear for children to wear when it is very wet and windy.





Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather e.g. sun hats, sun cream and wellington boots.

Please choose sensible footwear (enclosed shoes with no heels) which is suitable for outside play and climbing.

### **Promoting a love of Learning and Celebrating Achievement**









- Every year, our data shows that the children in Reception do very well from their starting points. With a strong increase in children becoming age related.
- In Year 1, children consistently achieve in line with the national average for the phonic screening.
- Pre-lock down, we achieved our highest achievement in combined end of KS2 attainment ever 71%, significantly above National
- All progress measures continue to be better than National

### **The Start of Reception**

In the first few days most children are very excited about starting school. Occasionally, we have children who are reluctant to leave their parent and this can be very distressing for both parties.

If this happens to you, please don't worry. The staff at the school will be only too willing to help in any way they can.

Here are some things that you can do to help:

- Give your child a big hug, and tell them who will be meeting them and when.
- Confidently hand them over to the teacher and say goodbye and leave.

If you feel upset please do telephone the school to reassure yourself that your child has settled.



### **Things You Need To Know**

For safety, please do not let your child wear jewellery. If your child has pierced ears they should wear studs.

When children are ill, we ask parents to keep them at home and telephone the school to let us know. The telephone number is: 01273 770777.

If your child has had an upset stomach or has been sick they need to stay at home for 48 hours to stop the spread of germs.

If your child needs to use an inhaler, an administration of medicine form must be filled in at the school office.

If your child has any medical conditions or allergies please make staff aware.

### **Starting in September**

- ► Friday 1<sup>st</sup> and Monday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2023- Staff Inset days (Children will not be at school)
- ► From Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2023 Reception children will attend on half days. For the duration of the half days, your child will be in a class with half of the children (i.e. no more than 15 children), this allows your child to get used to the classroom setting in a small group (please check your letter for times)
- Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September will be a morning session with lunch for all childrenyour child will start school at 8.40; you can come into the classroom with your child and stay to settle them. Parents/carers are invited to also have a lunch on this day with their child. <u>Please be in school for 11:30</u>. If you are not joining your child for lunch, you will need to collect your child at 12:30pm.
- ► Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> September will be a full day for all children. Your child will start school at 8.40; you can come into the classroom with your child and stay to settle them. You will need to collect your child at 3pm.
