



1. Support for Our City Our World project

Remind children of the Our City Our World project. Collect ideas from your class about what we can do as a school. Email sent to Ms Heym from school council to ask if there is anything we can do to support with this.

Clear up rubbish – 1 class to be responsible for picking up litter each week.

Use recyclable plastic in lunch boxes.

Make posters about nature.

Don't waste paper – use scrap paper.

Turn the board and lights off.
