Car Park Access & Arrival Times

Attendance Matters!

Thank you all for making the start of the term a calm and happy one for our children. Attendance is always a priority at West Blatchington and this year we really want to build on ensuring every child is able to **come to school on time, every day**.

As you know, when children are in school regularly and on time, they feel part of the team – they feel safe, happy and ready to learn!

Start and End of the Day

Why being on time matters:

- Children who arrive on time feel calm and ready to join in
- Being late can make your child feel rushed and unsettled, and they might miss important learning or social time

Why prompt pick up is important:

- At the end of the day, children are tired and ready to see a familiar face.
- Being picked up late can make them feel worried or unsure

If you are running late, just give the office a call so we can make sure your child is safe until you arrive.

Unfortunately, if we don't hear from you, or there are repeated patterns of lateness, we may need to charge for lateness if your child is collected after 3.25pm

School Absence Fines – a quick guide!

We know that life gets busy, and there may be occasions when your child misses school. But it is important to understand how school absence is monitored and when fines (penalty notices) might be issued.

What's the usual rule?

Normally, a fine can be issued if a child has 10 or more unauthorised absences (that's 5 full school days) within a 10 week period.

Can a fine be given before reaching 10 absences?

Yes – in some cases, a fine can be issued even if the 10 session threshold hasn't been met. This might happen if:

- A child is repeatedly taken out for short holidays that add up over time
- There are regular absences for things like birthdays or family events
- The school believes the absences are being deliberately planned to avoid reaching the threshold.

We are always available to talk through any attendance questions or queries you may have.






