For the safety and well-being of everyone in the school community it is necessary for us to work within a set of rules.

Our six school rules are clear and simple. They are used consistently and are linked with consequences.

They are:

- Walk quietly on the left.
- Speak to each other politely.
- Keep your hands and feet to yourself.
- Listen to and follow instructions.
- Attend school regularly and be on time.
- Keep the school environment clean and tidy.

At the beginning of each academic year teachers agree with pupils a set of class rules. These are displayed in the classroom to be used as a point of reference for maintaining high standards of behaviour for anyone working in that room; they are revised at the start of each half term.

Dining Hall Rules

- Always walk carefully in the hall.
- Stay in designated areas.
- Ask for permission before leaving the table.

Playground Rules

- Use kind words and actions toward everyone.
- Take care of school property and playground equipment.
- Be welcoming and invite others to join games or activities.
- Play only in approved areas of the playground.
