Bignor Roman Villa!

Swallows and Falcons enjoyed a fantastic day out at Bignor Roman Villa, one of Britain's best-preserved Roman sites. We were amazed by the beautiful mosaic floors, especially the famous Gorgon head and the long Winter Dining Room mosaic. Everyone listened attentively as the guide explained how the villa was once a thriving Roman farm, complete with baths, courtyards and living quarters.

During the hands-on workshops, the pupils threw themselves into becoming Romans for the day. They:

- Grinded their own flour using quern stones, discovering just how much effort went into making something as simple as bread.
- Learned to spin wool, trying out techniques that Roman families would have used daily.
- Designed their own mosaic tiles, inspired by the incredible patterns they had seen in the villa.
- Wrote on Roman-style wax writing tablets, practising the careful strokes needed to form letters with a stylus.

Everyone showed great curiosity, teamwork and enthusiasm throughout the visit. Their thoughtful questions and eagerness to try every activity made the day truly memorable.

A huge thank you to the staff at Bignor for their detailed tour, and well done to Swallows and Falcons for being such brilliant historians!

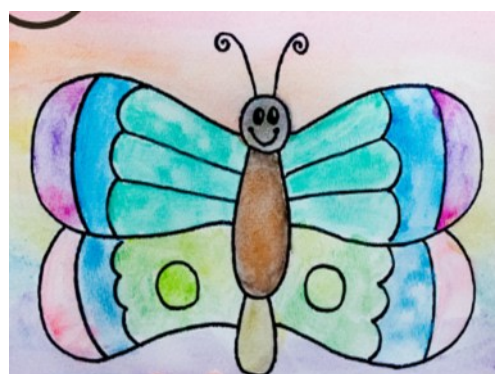

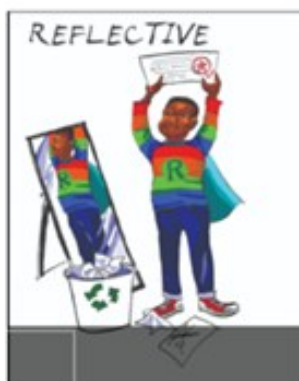


Spring Time School Council Activity

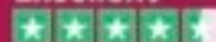
